Club Coach

The Club is looking at the possibility of employing a coach for our Club. In the first instance we are calling for expressions of interest in this role in a playing or nonplaying capacity.

MWBC is a Division 3 club for Weekend pennant and Division 2 for Midweek pennant. The Club is one of Melbourne's pre-eminent bowling clubs situated in the southeastern metro area. The club fields 2 Weekend and 2 Midweek Pennant sides along with Thursday, 9's and Night pennant. Reporting to the Committee of Management (COM), the successful applicant will be required to:

- Formulate and introduce training programs that will improve the playing performance of individual members of the Club.

- Enhance the skills of our bowlers and engender a pride in teams and achievement.

- Be a good communicator and able to engage with members of all ages and skill levels

- Work with COM and selection group on setting targets and monitor the performance of all pennant playing sides.

- Develop and assist the COM with recruitment and development of new bowlers.

The period of this agreement is for 7 months from 1 September 2024 to 31 March 2025 for approximately 8 hours per week.

Remuneration will be discussed and negotiated during the selection process. Enquiries will be handled with the strictest of confidence.

Speaking of coaching, David Beard has just received his Bowls Australia accreditation as an Introductory Coach and a Club Coach. David is heavily involved in our secondary and primary schools programs, corporate events and our Free Fridays where our local community can come and try lawn bowls. He undertook the coaching courses to ensure that he was starting these visitors with the right techniques to become potential future bowlers.

Club Improvements

Even though the pennant season is over, much activity is still occurring around the Club. Barrie, Graham and Howard have been busy inside the Clubhouse with:

- Replacing the open shelving in the kitchen alcove with built in cupboards
- Removing the chipboard shelving in the Dining Room store and installing steel cupboards
- Replacing our two hot water services with energy efficient heat pump HWS at no cost to the Club courtesy of the State Government's energy savings program
- Repainting the Committee Room
- Installing an electric hand dryer in the Mens toilet
- Installing replacement clocks in the kitchen and facing the centre green

There has been a new hedge trimmer purchased to assist Richard Horban and David Rae keeping the hedges surrounding our greens, neat and tidy from the Volunteer Grant funds received from the Federal Government.

The Club is also replacing the amplifier and speakers in the dining room, lounge and outside in time for our 60^{th} celebrations on 7 September.

West Green - Shade Awning

After spending over 6 months in securing a Building Permit for the project, we have finally been able to replace the previous shade awnings at the north end of our west green with a new continuous shade structure. The new shade provides improved sun protection for our bowlers and visitors and is less visually intrusive for our neighbours. The \$10,000 grant for this project was facilitated by our Federal Member, Dr Carina Garland.

The Club has recently purchased the Bowls Australia All Abilities Rookie Roller set to enable us to better cater for the primary and special school students that have started coming to the Club to learn how to play lawn bowls. These kits will also be useful for teaching the children that have been coming with their parents for our Free Friday sessions for the local community.



Holmesglen Students

MWBC is one of the local bowling clubs that have been approached by Holmesglen TAFE to provide practical support for their Bachelor of Sports Business and Media students. The proposal is mutually beneficial with the students seeing and learning how small sporting clubs actually operate, and the clubs gaining from the young person's perspective on the problems they are grappling with along with the latest developments in sports administration. For their next assignment, the students will be developing ways to promote the club to younger people to come and try lawn bowls for our website and a promotional video.
